As a research-oriented university, ASBU prioritizes postgraduate programs while promoting an interdisciplinary approach to address the complexity of social events. The university has expertise in specific areas through its multiple research centers and strives to explore social phenomena in both Eastern and Western contexts, transcending national and local boundaries via its various institutes. Additionally, ASBU aims to implement both short-term and long-term large-scale projects through cooperation and collaboration.



Rector's Message

The ASBU Research and Entrepreneurship Ecosystem hosts a variety of structures. One of the most important actors within this ecosystem is the ASBU Sosyokent Technology Development Zone. This unique model, which has few counterparts globally, aims to generate solutions to social problems, connect scientific knowledge with societal needs, and implement these solutions through concrete applications. Sosyokent brings together entrepreneurs who produce innovative ideas for social challenges with segments of society seeking solutions to these problems, under an institutional framework. Additionally, Sosyokent supports the systematic execution of social innovation activities through its affiliated centers, laboratories, and support offices, thus facilitating more effective interaction among stakeholders.

Another component of the ASBU Research and Entrepreneurship Ecosystem was established under the Project for the Development of Interdisciplinary Research Infrastructure. The Interdisciplinary Social Sciences Research Infrastructure (DİSAP), which is the first of its kind in Türkiye, is supported by the Presidency of Strategy and Budget. It aims to strengthen R&D capacity in the social sciences and increase research activities in line with a sustainable development vision. This project envisions the development of an integrated and nationwide structure that includes various interactive research laboratories, a shared human resources pool, common social areas, research centers, and stakeholders from the public sector, private sector, and civil society organizations (CSOs).

Another actor within the ecosystem is the Institute for Social Research and Innovation, established in 2022. The Institute aims to design, develop, and deliver to society interdisciplinary research in emerging fields in response to the paradigm shift in the social sciences. It will contribute to enhancing academic capacity and support scientific research and training of researchers within an "interdisciplinary research infrastructure" that will accelerate both scientific advancement and Türkiye's development.

Transforming its innovative approach in the social sciences into an institutional framework, ASBU takes a pioneering step with the Institute for Social Research and Innovation (SAYE). Developed in collaboration with Bilkent, METU, Hacettepe, and Marmara Universities, this next-generation institute model aims to lead interdisciplinary projects in the field of social sciences and to train highly qualified researchers. SAYE is committed not only to producing academic knowledge but also to generating innovative solutions that translate this knowledge into social benefit. By integrating education, research, and practice, SAYE significantly strengthens ASBU's vision of becoming a national and international point of reference in the social sciences.

ASBU, located in the heart of Türkiye's capital city, aims to be a strategic center for transforming knowledge into valuable assets for both the private and civil sectors through its focus on social entrepreneurship. It will serve as a hub for individuals and organisations seeking solutions, transformation, change, and progress. In addition to its social contributions in the areas of education, research, and social entrepreneurship, ASBU is committed to fulfilling its mission through various local, national, and international social responsibility projects and activities. 

- has a strong ambition to contribute to the community in general.




Vision



ASBU as a research-oriented university

ASBU is a research-oriented university for both undergraduate and graduate studies.

ASBU university model focus on research centers. Social problems and possible solutions are discussed firstly in research centers. Then discussions about problems and the possible solutions become publications such as reports, boks, articles, papers and so on which aims to offer a specific contribution to the solution of social problems.

While institutes of the university reproduces the problems and solutions discussed in the research centers by feeding master's and doctoral programs, faculties of the university aim to disseminate this information.

The university model of ASBU which focuses on research centers is conscious and determined choice. This university model focus on original information production and it enables information to be used, spread and sustainable.

As a research-oriented university, ASBU aims at giving priority to postgraduate programs, disseminating and deepening the interdisciplinary approach required by the complexity of social events, having expertise in certain areas through its several research centres, discovering the social phenomena of Eastern and Western worlds beyond national/local borders through its various institutes, and realising short and long term big scale projects via cooperations and collaborations.


Among the university's primary aims is the publication of social sciences research that positively contributes to the international literature. To that end, ASBU encourages its academic staff and students to engage in national-international scientific projects, and supports their effective use of social sciences research funds provided by national and international bodies.



Interdisciplinary Approach

Undergraduate and postgraduate programmes of ASBU are designed in a manner that support interdisciplinary activities and enable our students to be informed about the output of various disciplines.

Our undergraduate and postgraduate programmes provide opportunities for our students to choose from a large pool of elective courses from different departments, and in this manner, enhance their knowledge in the chosen field of their own interest.





At ASBU, our students are regarded as active participants in learning processes; our aim is to equip them with skills, which will enable them to acquire critical knowledge, to evaluate and to interpret it after assessing it analytically and critically, and to apply it to current affairs and discussions.

Our education at ASBU is not limited to theoretical knowledge; we aim to teach our students research methods and processes by enrolling them actively in research projects and by assigning them tasks and responsibilities.

In this way, our students will not only be participants in theoretical and conceptual discussions, but also become knowledgeable about the national and international institutions that are active in their fields of interest and to develop contacts with them.

Our University offers extra-curricular programmes to improve the non-academic skills of our students, to provide opportunities for participation in social activities at their leisure time.





Academic Staff

ASBU Sosyokent Technopark

ASBU Sosyokent has been positioned as a key component of the university's research and entrepreneurship ecosystem design. As a Technology Development Zone, ASBU Sosyokent aims to specialize in social innovation and entrepreneurship with the goal of contributing to the resolution of social problems in Türkiye and the wider region.

ASBU Sosyokent is located within the ASBU Main Campus, covering a 7,090 m² area situated at the heart of the campus. This area consists of two buildings and a garden-parking lot. Both historical buildings were reinforced for earthquake resistance and restored by ASBU in accordance with their original structure. The buildings within the zone consist of two independent blocks.

ASBU Sosyokent brings together entrepreneurs who generate innovative ideas to address social challenges and segments of society seeking solutions to these problems under an institutional framework. It supports the systematic implementation of social innovation activities and fosters more effective interaction among stakeholders through its affiliated centers, laboratories, and support offices. These services not only provide entrepreneurs with access to the university's social science research infrastructure but also contribute to the development and commercialization of products and services.

Since August 2022, ASBU Sosyokent has started accepting entrepreneurs' R&D projects into the zone. It is the first technology development zone in Türkiye to specialize in social entrepreneurship and innovation. Numerous high-impact social benefit projects are being carried out in areas such as climate change, local business mapping, health-focused solutions, smart city solutions, management information systems, and institutional system design. A shared incubation office has also been launched to include and support young entrepreneurs.

The ASBU Research and Entrepreneurship Ecosystem is a collaborative model that brings together scientific research and development, research infrastructure, application centers, postgraduate education, and the Technopark, representing entrepreneurs. The primary mission of Technoparks is to commercialize knowledge in order to address social problems and ultimately enhance the country's competitiveness. The objective is not merely to establish a Technopark, but to design the support mechanisms and infrastructure needed by entrepreneurs within it, and to increase R&D capacity for developing scientific and technological knowledge that can be commercialized.

With the help of the Language Studies Center, the university provides its students the opportunity to learn other foreign languages in addition to English, according to their area interest, in an environment that facilitates broadening of the their horizons through use of language.




Faculty of Divinity (30% English)


